Conditions of contract:

- Exhibitor agrees to occupy assigned space defined as 1 rectangular table with 2 chairs and extra table for additional \$50, if desired and reserved by vendor registration deadline
- Exhibitor will provide her/his own table covers
- Exhibitors shall **only sell new or handmade items**. (This is not a yard sale or flea market!)
- Exhibitor shall keep space in good order and will not damage walls, tables or fixtures in exhibit areas. All vendor areas will be inspected at the close of the show.
- Exhibitors may not share or sublet the reserved space or reassign this contract without prior approval of the Mount Ephraim Baptist Church Scholarship Ministry. If approved, a new signed contract shall be required from each exhibitor.
- Mount Ephraim Baptist Church shall not be responsible for any loss, theft or damage of vendor merchandise during show hours
- Exhibitors will be responsible for collecting their own sales tax
