



Ballot applications are set to begin mailing between August 24th and August 31st. The deadline for requesting ballots has been moved up to October 20th.

If you'd like the safety and convenience of mailing in your ballot, don't wait for that, request your ballot today. This will help lessen the last minute crush on the Board of Elections. There are three ways you can request a mail in ballot:

1) Online if you have a Maryland driver's license or MVA-issued ID card. Click the following link to begin the request, even if you have already registered to vote:

2) Complete and return one of the forms below. Read the instructions, enter the required information, print the form, sign it, and return it to your County Board of Elections.
